

DESTINY DISCOVER

The library management system that we use for our district's media centers is Follett's Destiny Discover. Students have an icon for Destiny on their Clever page when they log in to their chromebooks, but, unfortunately, that icon is not working right now. The good news is that students can still get to Destiny, just through a more roundabout method:

In a new tab in their Google browser, students should type

waps.follettdestiny.com into the address bar. That will take them to a page that lists all WAPS media centers. Clicking on "Winona Middle School" will then take them to our WMS Destiny site, which they can bookmark for future access. Students do not have to log in to their Destiny accounts to search for books. The only reason they would need to log in to Destiny would be to place holds on books or see their checkouts. If they do want to log in, their user name and password are the same as what they use to log in to their chromebooks.
