Allows grades 7-12 who take CBs off-campus to have devices covered under three-year ADP coverage. Allows grades 3-6 who do not take CBs off-campus to get new devices on a four year rotation and be covered by ADP for years 1-3. 2023-24 - District will have adequate off-lease CB quantity to equip grades 4-6 with quality devices.
