SMART Boards - working with teachers on use of SMART Mirror and Miracast for wireless connections to the SMART Boards. Wired and SMART Mirror connections working well. Continuing to troubleshoot issues with Miracast. b. TVs/Airtame - Airtame connections to TVs being tested in the pilot classrooms at WMS/WSHS for mirroring staff/student devices wirelessly to the TVs. Scheduling a call with Airtame support to troubleshoot some connection issues. New feature updates from Airtame will be evaluated to assist with any connection issues. c. Expansion of pilot - Consideration for adding additional classrooms to the secondary pilot of both SMART Board and TV display technologies. Will make a decision once we have resolved the connectivity questions. d. Survey - Planning for a staff survey to gather information on teacher use of classroom display technology to assist with developing a recommendation for the secondary classrooms.
